Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Embarkation in Esna and Khnum Temple

Your adventure begins with a scenic drive from Luxor to the lively merchant town of Esna. Upon arrival, you will board the Adelaide Dahabiya 6 Days From Luxor Aswan and meet the dedicated crew who will be your hosts for the coming week. The first cultural stop is the remarkable Temple of Khnum, an ancient sanctuary that sits an incredible 9 meters below the current street level, requiring a walk through local markets filled with exotic textiles and spices. After exploring the temple's intricate carvings, you will return to the boat for a welcome dinner and your first night spent anchored in the serene waters of Esna.

Day 2: El Kab's Tombs and Edfu's Grand Temple

As the Adelaide Dahabiya 6 Days From Luxor Aswan sails to the East Bank, you will reach the ancient city of El Kab, the former capital of Upper Egypt. You will take a scenic walk through a small fishermen's village to reach the necropolis, where a row of decorated tombs is carved directly into the mountain slope. In the afternoon, the vessel arrives at Edfu, where a traditional horse-drawn carriage waits to take you to the Temple of Horus, one of the best-preserved Greco-Roman structures in the world. After marvelling at its massive pylons, you will return to the boat and set sail for a tranquil island anchorage for the night.

After walking through the historic stone-cutting sites, you will return to the Sailing Boat for a picturesque lunch while navigating toward your next destination. The afternoon offers more leisure time and opportunities for swimming as you soak in the untouched natural beauty of the riverbanks.

Day 5: Kom Ombo's Twin Temple and Crocodile Museum

After a night spent beneath the stars, your morning is dedicated to the town of Kom Ombo, situated on a beautiful bend in the river. You will explore the striking Temple of Kom Ombo, a unique Ptolemaic masterpiece dedicated symmetrically to the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Haroeris. Following the temple tour, you will visit the adjacent Crocodile Museum to see mummified remains that highlight the vital religious importance of these creatures in antiquity. Your final evening on the Adelaide Dahabiya 6 Days From Luxor Aswan is celebrated with a farewell dinner and a night of tranquility as the desert landscape closes in.

Day 6: Arrival in Aswan and Disembarkation
