Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Luxor Grandeur, Transfer & Embarkation

An intensive morning of sightseeing in ancient Thebes is followed by a scenic transfer and boarding the Dahabiya.

Luxor Sightseeing: Early morning pickup from your Luxor (Airport / Hotel / Train station). Start with a visit to the magnificent Karnak Temple, the largest and most important religious complex in ancient Egypt. Then, cross the Nile to the West Bank to visit the Valley of the Kings (exploring 3 tombs), the unique funerary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, and the colossal Colossi of Memnon.

Embarkation: After the tour, you will drive (approximately 1 hour) to Esna to embark your Akhnaton Dahabiya Nile Cruise. The crew will welcome you on board and ensure your bags are taken to your cabins.

Sailing & Overnight: We will immediately set sail for El Hegz Island, where the Dahabiya will moor for the night. Enjoy your Dinner on the sundeck or on the tranquil bank of the river Nile. Overnight on board.

Meals: Lunch, Dinner

Day 2: Sailing to Edfu and Ramadi's Peaceful Shores

A day of relaxing sailing and visiting one of Egypt's most intact temples.

Breakfast & Edfu: Enjoy Breakfast at your leisure while gently sailing to Edfu, arriving around noon time. Upon arrival, you will enjoy a traditional horse and carriage ride (return journey) to visit Edfu Temple, one of Egypt's largest and most intact ancient monuments.

Scenic Sailing: Enjoy Lunch onboard and continue sailing south. Experience the peaceful, picturesque, and magic nature along the River Nile, slowly passing by the plain life of the farmers and fishermen and the green, fertile landscapes with sugar cane fields, bananas, and date palm-trees.

Ramadi Anchorage: Shortly before sunset, we drop anchor near Ramadi Island, where we enjoy



Dinner in an atmospheric setting on the riverbank. Overnight on board.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 3: Gebel el-Silsila and Kom Ombo Approach

Explore the hidden quarries and rock shrines before anchoring at a secluded island.

Early Sail & Silsila: An early morning sail takes us to Gebel el-Silsila. Enjoy Breakfast on board before going ashore to discover the old Pharaonic quarries of Silsela and the little-known rock-cut Temple of Hormoheb. From the top of the mountain, we enjoy a breathtaking view over the Nile Valley.

Sailing South: Later on, set sailing toward Kom Ombo. Listen to the sounds of the water buffalo as they wade in the shallow water beside the banks of the Nile, the donkeys as they go about their day-to-day business, and the various bird life of the river.

Island Overnight: We stay at the edge of Al Bashir Island for Dinner and overnight anchoring.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 4: Kom Ombo Temple and Sailing to Aswan

Visit the unique double temple before dedicating the day to the beautiful sail to Aswan.

Kom Ombo Temple: Sail to Kom Ombo. After Breakfast, visit the unique Kom Ombo Temple, where you explore the exceptional, beautifully preserved double temple of Haroeris (Horus the Elder) and Sobek (the Crocodile God). The temple was built with two symmetric entrances, halls, and sanctuaries—the only double temple in all of Egypt.

Sailing to Aswan: Enjoy Lunch on board and proceed to Aswan city. The rest of the day is dedicated to sailing, allowing you to relax and enjoy the scenery as the Akhnaton Dahabiya cruises toward the Aswan West Bank.

Overnight in Aswan: Dinner and overnight are spent near Aswan.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner



Day 5: Aswan Excursions & Final Departure

The cruise concludes with tours of Aswan's key sites.

Disembarkation & Aswan Tours: Disembarkation takes place after Breakfast. Your final visits include the massive Unfinished Obelisk, the modern marvel of the High Dam, and the beautiful Philae Temple Island.

Departure: Later on, you will be transferred to your next destination in Aswan (Hotel, Airport, train station).

Meals: Breakfast.
