Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Aswan and the Island of Isis

Your luxury holiday begins with a warm welcome at Aswan Airport or the railway station, where your tour manager will meet you and provide a private transfer to the MS Al Nabilatan. After checking in and enjoying your first gourmet lunch on board, you will embark on a historical tour of Aswan with your expert Egyptologist. You will take a short boat trip to Agilkia Island to visit the breathtaking Philae Temple, a sanctuary dedicated to the goddess Isis that was rescued from the rising waters of Lake Nasser by UNESCO. The tour continues with a visit to the Aswan High Dam, a massive 20th-century engineering feat that provides a panoramic view of the world's largest man-made lake. You will return to the vessel for dinner and spend your first night anchored in the peaceful waters of Aswan.

Day 2: Sailing to Kom Ombo and Optional Abu Simbel

The morning is yours to relax and enjoy the 5-star amenities of the Al Nabilatan, or you may choose a legendary early-morning optional excursion to the Abu Simbel Temples, the massive rock-cut monuments of Ramses II. After lunch on board, anchors are away as the ship begins sailing downstream toward Kom Ombo. This is the perfect time to enjoy the sundeck pool or the panoramic views from your cabin. Upon arrival, you will visit the Temple of Kom Ombo, a unique dual sanctuary perfectly symmetrical along its main axis and dedicated to both the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Haroeris. You will explore the twin halls and sanctuaries before returning to the boat for dinner as you continue sailing toward Edfu.

Day 3: Edfu's Falcon Temple and the Grandeur of Luxor

Your third day starts with a charming horse and carriage ride through the streets of Edfu to reach the Temple of Horus, the most complete and best-preserved ancient temple in Egypt. After returning to the cruise for lunch, you will enjoy a relaxing afternoon of sailing toward Luxor, witnessing the fascinating process of crossing the Esna Lock. Upon arrival in Luxor, your exploration of the East Bank begins with the Karnak Temple Complex, a staggering assembly of pylons and giant pillars that served as the most important religious center of ancient Egypt. You will also visit the 3,400-year-old Luxor Temple, built by Amenhotep III and Ramses II, which glows beautifully as evening falls. You will spend your final night enjoying dinner and entertainment on board in Luxor.



Day 4: West Bank Wonders and Final Departure

On your final morning, you have the option to take a sunrise hot air balloon ride over the ruins of Luxor for an unforgettable perspective of the Nile Valley. After breakfast on board, you will check out and head to the West Bank to visit the legendary Valley of the Kings, where you will enter the burial chambers of Egypt's most powerful Pharaohs. The tour continues to the striking, multi-terraced Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, carved directly into the limestone cliffs, and concludes at the Colossi of Memnon, the two massive stone statues of Amenhotep III. Following the tours, our representative will provide a private transfer to the Luxor airport or railway station for your final departure, marking the end of your extraordinary journey with Bastet Travel.
