Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Luxor and East Bank Wonders

Your luxury adventure begins with a warm welcome by our representative at Luxor airport or the railway station, followed by a private transfer to the MS Al Nabilatan. After check-in and your first gourmet lunch on board, you will join your expert Egyptologist to visit the Temple of Karnak, a massive religious complex built over 1,000 years. You will then explore the Luxor Temple, established in the 14th century BC and expanded by Ramses II. The evening is free for relaxation, or you may choose an optional Sound and Light Show at Karnak before your first overnight stay on the water.

Day 2: Sailing to Edfu and Folkloric Evening

The morning is yours to enjoy the 5-star amenities of the Al Nabilatan or take an optional hot air balloon flight for a sunrise view of the royal necropolis from the sky. As the ship begins its elegant journey toward Edfu, you can relax on the sundeck and witness the vibrant life along the Nile banks. After a delicious dinner on board, the staff will operate a vibrant folkloric show, introducing you to the traditional music and dance of Egypt. You will spend the night anchored in Edfu, enjoying the gentle rhythm of the river.

Day 3: The Dual Temple of Kom Ombo

Following an energizing breakfast, the ship reaches the unique location of the Temple of Kom Ombo. This Ptolemaic-era masterpiece is famously dedicated to two gods: Sobek the crocodile and Haroeris the eagle. Your guide will explain the fascinating symmetry of the architecture before you return to the ship for lunch. The afternoon is dedicated to scenic sailing toward Aswan, providing the perfect opportunity to utilize the cruise facilities or simply relax on your private balcony with a view of the immortal River Nile. The evening concludes with a music performance by the onboard staff.

Day 4: Felucca Sailing and Aswan's Island Beauty

Spend a tranquil morning on the sundeck as the Al Nabilatan completes its journey to Aswan. In the afternoon, you will experience the Nile the traditional way, sailing on a Felucca (sailing boat) around the picturesque islands of Aswan, including Kitchener's Island and the Agha Khan Mausoleum. After your afternoon tea on board, the evening remains free for leisure. You may choose an optional



Sound and Light Show at the island-based Philae Temple to learn about the legends of Isis and Osiris before enjoying a folkloric show and dinner on board.

Day 5: Aswan High Dam and the Temple of Isis

Today is dedicated to exploring the highlights of Aswan with your expert guide. You will first visit the High Dam, a monumental engineering project that created Lake Nasser. You will then ride a motorboat to the romantic Philae Temple, a Greco-Roman cult center for the goddess Isis. The final stop is the Unfinished Obelisk, located in the ancient granite quarries. After your tours, you will return to the ship for a tasty lunch and an afternoon of relaxation. The evening offers another chance for an optional Sound and Light show or exploring the local Aswan spice markets.

Day 6: The Magnificent Temple of Horus in Edfu

Early this morning, the Al Nabilatan begins its return leg toward Luxor. After breakfast, you will visit the Temple of Horus in Edfu, which is recognized as the most complete and best-preserved temple in all of Egypt. Constructed in the 3rd century BC, its soaring pylons and detailed reliefs are a highlight of the journey. You will return to the ship for lunch while sailing back toward Luxor, witnessing the fascinating crossing of the Esna Lock. The evening is free for you to enjoy the high-end service on board as the landscape of Upper Egypt drifts by.

Day 7: The Valley of the Kings and Theban Necropolis

Your final full day of discovery focuses on the "City of the Dead" on Luxor's West Bank. After breakfast, you will explore the Valley of the Kings, the richest and most fascinating necropolis in Egypt, where the Pharaohs of the New Kingdom were buried. You will then visit the stunning multi-terraced Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir el-Bahari and conclude your tour at the Colossi of Memnon, the massive statues that served as landmarks for the funerary temple of Amenhotep III. You will return to the boat for a final celebratory dinner and overnight stay in Luxor.

Day 8: Final Check-out and Departure

After a wonderful final breakfast on board the MS Al Nabilatan, you will complete your check-out at 8:00 AM. Depending on your flight or train schedule, you may have time for one last stroll through Luxor's vibrant bazaars or an optional visit to the Valley of the Nobles.
