Tour Itinerary

Day 01: Aswan Day Tour and Sail to Kom Ombo

Your luxury adventure begins with a warm meet and greet at Aswan Airport or the railway station, where your representative will facilitate your arrival and introduce you to your expert Egyptologist guide. Your first stop is the remarkable Philae Temple, an ancient sanctuary famously moved to Agilkia Island to save it from the rising waters of Lake Nasser. After exploring the temple's intricate carvings, you will visit the Aswan High Dam, the massive structure that gave birth to one of the world's largest man-made lakes. Day 02: Kom Ombo Sightseeing and Sail to Speos of Horemheb

After a leisurely breakfast on the deck of your Dahabiya, you will disembark to explore the fascinating Kom Ombo Temple. This Greco-Roman masterpiece is unique for its perfectly symmetrical dual design, built to honor the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Haroeris simultaneously. Your guide will share the remarkable history of this "mirror" temple before you return to the MS Amoura for another fine lunch as the yacht sails toward Gebel el Silsila. This area is a rare gem where the Nile flows at its narrowest point. You will then tie up alongside the ancient rock-hewn Speos of Horemheb, an exclusive site that large cruise ships cannot access. Weather permitting, the highlight of the evening is an unforgettable dinner served within the grounds of the illuminated temple itself, accompanied by soft music and the mesmerizing glow of the ancient stone. The day ends with a peaceful night's rest in the comfort of your luxury cabin.

Day 03: Edfu Sightseeing, Island Dinner, and Sail to Esna

Start your day with another relaxed breakfast before heading to the city of Edfu for a truly unique experience. You will travel to the Temple of Horus in a lovely horse-drawn carriage, passing through the local streets to reach what is considered the best-preserved ancient temple in Egypt. Having been buried under sand for nearly 2,000 years, its reliefs and pylons remain in staggering condition. After your temple tour, you can explore the extensive nearby bazaar by foot or carriage, stopping for authentic souvenirs and textiles. Returning to the Amoura, you will sail toward a tiny, secluded



island in the Nile. Here, everyone disembarks for a magical island dinner featuring traditional Egyptian entertainment under the stars. As the night progresses, the yacht sails slowly toward Esna, allowing you to drift to sleep in the blissful comfort of your panoramic cabin while anchored in the calm waters.

Day 04: Disembarkation and Luxor Monuments Tour
