## Tour Itinerary

### Day 1: Arrival in Aswan and the Sanctuary of Isis

Your Eyearu Dahabiya 4 Days Aswan Luxor adventure begins with a professional meet and assist service by a Bastet Travel representative at the Aswan airport or railway station. You will be transferred in a private air-conditioned vehicle to the Dahabiya for embarkation and a warm welcome. After a fresh lunch on board, you will join your Egyptologist guide to explore the highlights of Aswan. The tour begins at the High Dam, a modern engineering marvel, followed by a motorboat trip to the stunning Philae Temple, an island sanctuary dedicated to the goddess Isis. You will also visit the Unfinished Obelisk, which lies in its ancient granite quarry, offering a unique look at Pharaonic stonework. Return to the Eyearu for a sunset dinner and your first night of silent sailing on the Nile.

### Day 2: Temples of the River and Hidden Quarries

Enjoy a quiet breakfast on the sundeck as the Eyearu Dahabiya 4 Days Aswan Luxor sails toward the unique Temple of Kom Ombo. This rare double temple is dedicated to both the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Haroeris, and it features fascinating reliefs of ancient medical tools. The journey continues to the exclusive site of Gebel El-Silsila, an ancient sandstone quarry and temple site accessible only to smaller vessels. Here, you will explore the shrines of the pharaohs carved directly into the cliffs overlooking the river. In the afternoon, visit the Temple of Horus in Edfu via a traditional horse-drawn carriage. This is the most well-preserved temple in Egypt, providing an immersive look at ancient religious life. Return to the ship for an evening cooking class and dinner.

### Day 3: The West Bank Necropolis and Royal Secrets

As the Dahabiya reaches Luxor, the morning is dedicated to the legendary West Bank. After a gourmet breakfast, your guide will escort you to the Valley of the Kings, where you will explore the elaborately decorated tombs of the New Kingdom's greatest rulers. The tour continues to the striking Mortuary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, which rises in magnificent terraces from the desert floor. You will also stop to admire the Colossi of Memnon, the massive twin statues of Amenhotep III. In the afternoon, the Eyearu Dahabiya 4 Days Aswan Luxor offers a visit to the village of Bassaw, where you can experience authentic local life and meet with a resident family to learn about their traditions. Return to the boat for a final celebratory dinner under the stars.



#### **Day 4: East Bank Grandeur and Final Departure**

Following a final 5-star breakfast on the Nile, you will check out of the Eyaruh Dahabiya 4 Days Aswan Luxor. The final chapter of your journey explores the magnificent East Bank of Luxor. You will visit the Karnak Temple Complex, a massive site built over 1,500 years and home to the awe-inspiring Hypostyle Hall. The tour concludes at the elegant Luxor Temple, located in the heart of the modern city and once linked to Karnak by the Avenue of Sphinxes. After completing your sightseeing, a Bastet Travel representative will provide a private transfer to the Luxor airport or station for your final departure.
