## Tour Itinerary

### Day 1: Arrival in Luxor and Timeless East Bank Treasures

The tour begins at the Karnak Temple Complex, a staggering site of pylons and obelisks built over 1,500 years. You will then visit the elegant Luxor Temple, which served as the center of the ancient Opet festival. Return to the ship for dinner and an evening of relaxation under the glass pergola as the ship moors in Luxor.

### Day 2: West Bank Wonders and the Start of Silent Sailing

After a delicious breakfast on the sundeck, your guide will escort you to the legendary West Bank. You will delve into the Valley of the Kings, exploring the elaborately decorated tombs of the New Kingdom's greatest pharaohs. The tour continues to the striking Mortuary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, rising in terraces from the desert floor, and the towering Colossi of Memnon, the last remnants of Amenhotep III's funerary temple. Return to the Eyearu Dahabiya 5 Days Luxor Aswan for lunch as the vessel begins its silent, peaceful voyage south. Enjoy afternoon tea while watching the sunset over the Nile, followed by a refined dinner as the ship traverses the Esna Lock.

### Day 3: Edfu, Kom Ombo, and Cultural Immersion

The third day of your Eyearu Dahabiya Nile Cruise focuses on the river's most sacred temples and local life. After breakfast, you will visit the Temple of Horus in Edfu via horse-drawn carriage. As the most perfectly preserved temple in Egypt, its soaring halls offer a vivid look at ancient religious ceremonies. Later, the ship sails to the rare double Temple of Kom Ombo, uniquely honoring both the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Haroeris. Between these visits, you will enjoy a cultural stop at Bassaw Village to experience traditional hospitality and visit a local home. The evening concludes with a lively Egyptian folklore show and a themed dinner on the ship's sundeck.

### Day 4: Aswan's Engineering Marvels and Island Sanctuaries

As the Dahabiya arrives in Aswan, the day is dedicated to the region's core treasures. After



breakfast, you will visit the High Dam, a 20th-century engineering marvel that created Lake Nasser. You will then take a motorboat trip to the stunning Philae Temple, a beautiful island sanctuary dedicated to the goddess Isis that was rescued from the rising waters of the Nile. The final stop is the Unfinished Obelisk, located in the ancient granite quarries, providing insight into the pharaonic stone-cutting techniques. Return to the ship for a farewell dinner, perhaps preceded by an optional visit to the Sound and Light Show at Philae. Spend your final night on the river enjoying the absolute privacy of the Eyaru.
