Tour Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival in Luxor & The Grandeur of the East Bank

You will spend your first night on board the cruise in Luxor.

Day 02: Free Morning in Luxor & Scenic Sailing to Edfu

Enjoy a refreshing breakfast on board followed by a free morning in Luxor to explore at your own pace. For the more adventurous, an optional morning Hot Air Balloon ride over the West Bank of Luxor is available, providing an unparalleled view of the royal necropolis from the sky. The rest of the day is at leisure as the Mojito begins its graceful sail toward the city of Edfu. This is the perfect time to enjoy the ship's world-class facilities, such as the swimming pool or the sun deck, while watching the rural beauty of the Nile drift by. Dinner will be served on board, followed by a lively Egyptian folkloric show operated by the staff. You will spend the night on board as the vessel navigates the river.

Day 03: The Dual Sanctuary of Kom Ombo & Musical Evenings

An energizing breakfast will be served on board as the cruise continues its journey. Today's tour begins in Kom Ombo, where the ship docks directly at the unique Temple of Kom Ombo. This dual-dedicated temple, established in the Ptolemaic period, is a symmetrical masterpiece honoring both Sobek, the crocodile god, and Haroeris, the falcon god. After exploring this rare architectural site, you will return to the ship for a delicious lunch while continuing the sail toward Aswan. Day 04: Aswan's River Charms & Traditional Felucca Sailing

Your final historical visit will be to the Unfinished Obelisk, located in the granite quarry in the southern part of Aswan, providing a fascinating glimpse into the colossal scale of ancient stone construction. After the tour, return to your Nile Cruise for lunch. The evening is free, or you can opt for another visit to the city's vibrant souks. Overnight on board in Aswan.

Day 06: The Falcon Temple & Sailing North to Luxor

The Nile Cruise begins its sail back toward Luxor in the early morning hours. Enjoy breakfast on board before starting your day tour to the Temple of Horus in Edfu. Recognized as the most perfectly preserved ancient Egyptian temple, this Ptolemaic structure offers incredible detail in its reliefs and pylons. After this marvelous visit, you will return to the ship for lunch while sailing back toward the city of Luxor. The afternoon and evening are free for leisure to enjoy the tranquil sailing process, reflecting on the journey and taking in the sunset over the desert hills. Dinner and overnight stay remain on board as the vessel returns to the Theban region.

Day 07: West Bank Wonders: The City of the Dead

Enjoy your delicious breakfast as the ship moors back in Luxor. The morning is at leisure, or you can choose another optional Hot Air Balloon ride if you missed it earlier in the week. You will then join your guide to explore the "City of the Dead" on the West Bank. Visits include the world-famous



Valley of the Kings, home to the richly decorated tombs of New Kingdom pharaohs. Next is the spectacular mortuary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir el-Bahari, a unique terraced structure carved into the limestone cliffs. Your final visit is to the Colossi of Memnon, two gigantic statues that served as guardians for Amenhotep III's funerary temple. You will return to your Nile Cruise boat for a celebratory final dinner and overnight stay.

Day 08: Disembarkation & Final Departure

On your final morning, you will enjoy breakfast on board before completing the check-out and disembarkation process.
