Tour Itinerary

Day 1: The Gateway to Ancient Thebes

Your royal voyage begins in Luxor, where the scent of history fills the air. After a professional meet-and-assist service, you will explore the Karnak Temple Complex, a massive assembly of sanctuaries and towering pylons. Continue to the 3,400-year-old Luxor Temple, an architectural masterpiece built by Amenhotep III and Ramses II. Afterward, a private transfer brings you to the SS Misr to check into your royal suite. Spend the evening relaxing on this historic vessel as you soak in the vintage atmosphere and enjoy a refined dinner.

Day 2: Royal Tombs and Alabaster Artistry

Start your second day with an optional sunrise hot air balloon ride or proceed to the West Bank to visit the Colossi of Memnon and the world-renowned Valley of the Kings. Enjoy a cultural visit to a local Artisan Village to witness the traditional craft of Alabaster carving before exploring the multi-terraced Temple of Queen Hatshepsut. In the afternoon, the Mövenpick SS Misr sets sail toward Edfu, allowing you to enjoy a quiet sunset from the deck and witness the engineering of the Esna Lock.

Day 3: Mythical Temples of Edfu & Kom Ombo

Begin your morning with a traditional horse carriage ride to the Temple of Horus in Edfu, the most complete cult temple in Egypt. Return to the SS Misr for lunch as the ship glides south toward Kom Ombo. Here, you will visit the unique Temple of Kom Ombo, famous for its dual-entry design and perfectly symmetrical halls dedicated to Sobek and Haroeris. Continue sailing south while enjoying a refined dinner in the Marasem Restaurant.

Day 4: Aswan's Island Jewels and Engineering

After a royal breakfast, take a boat to Agilika Island to visit the rescued Philae Temple, dedicated to the goddess Isis. The tour continues to the Aswan High Dam, a modern engineering marvel, and includes an educational visit to an Aromatherapy Workshop to learn about ancient oils. As the sun sets, relax on the SS Misr or choose an optional authentic trip to a nearby Nubian Village to explore its vibrant colors and local culture.



Day 5: Optional Abu Simbel & Departure

On your final morning, you have the option to join a dawn excursion to the colossal Abu Simbel Temples of Ramses II and Nefertari. Alternatively, enjoy a peaceful final morning on the SS Misr before checking out at 8:00 AM. Your historic journey concludes with a private transfer to Aswan Airport or the railway station, ensuring you depart with a Sovereign Standard of memories from your time aboard this floating time capsule.
