Kom Ombo

At **Kom Ombo**, the **8 Days Cairo to Aswan Tour** presents a uniquely dual-structured Ptolemaic temple dedicated symmetrically to **Sobek** and **Horus**, situated 40 km north of **Aswan** and dating to the period between 332 BC and 395 AD one of the most architecturally distinctive stops in this **Egypt Tour Package**.

Aswan

The **8 Days Cairo to Aswan Tour** concludes its river journey in **Aswan** with the **Aswan High Dam** a 3.6-kilometer rock-fill dam completed in 1968 that formed **Lake Nasser** the **Philae Temple** dedicated to **Isis**, and the **Unfinished Obelisk** weighing 1,168 tonnes, the three defining monuments of the southern chapter of this **Egypt Tour Package**.

 - **Museum of Egyptian Antiquities (Egyptian Museum)** — Displaying over 120,000 authentic artifacts in **Tahrir Square**, including the complete **Treasures Room** of **Tutankhamun** his golden mask, throne, canopic jars, and burial goods discovered in 1922 and an optional **Mummies Room** housing royal remains
 - **Islamic Quarter (Islamic Cairo)** — The medieval city quarter surrounding **Al-Azhar** and the **Fatimid walls**, home to centuries-old mosques, madrasas, and one of the densest concentrations of Islamic architecture in the world
 - **Khan el-Khalili Bazaar** — A labyrinthine market established in 1382 during the Mamluk era, stretching across the **al-Muizz** district and functioning continuously as **Cairo's** most atmospheric center of trade, craftsmanship, and street culture
 - **River Nile** — The world's longest river and the lifeblood of Egyptian civilization for over 5,000 years, experienced across four nights aboard your **5-star luxury Nile Cruise** between **Luxor** and **Aswan**

 - **Edfu Temple** — The best-preserved ancient temple in Egypt, a Ptolemaic sanctuary dedicated to the hawk-god **Horus**, built between 246 BC and 57 BC, with walls carrying the full text of the **Myth of the Contending of Horus and Seth**
 - **Kom Ombo Temple** — A uniquely symmetrical double-deity Ptolemaic temple 40 km north of **Aswan**, dedicated equally to the crocodile god **Sobek** and the falcon god **Horus**, dating to the period 332 BC-395 AD



- **Aswan High Dam** — A 3.6-kilometer rock-fill dam completed in 1968 and inaugurated in 1971, forming **Lake Nasser** one of the world's largest artificial reservoirs, stretching over 550 km across Egypt and Sudan
- **Philae Temple** — The final temple built in the classical Egyptian style, dedicated to the goddess **Isis**, with construction beginning around 690 BC and the entire structure relocated to **Agilkia Island** between 1972 and 1980 in a landmark UNESCO preservation project
- **Unfinished Obelisk** — An abandoned granite monument in **Aswan's Northern Quarries** estimated at 1,168 tonnes, which had it been completed would have been the single heaviest piece of stone ever fashioned by the ancient Egyptians

Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo

The 8 Days Cairo to Aswan Tour begins at Cairo International Airport, where a Bastet Travel tour manager meets you in the arrivals hall, assists with entry formalities, and escorts you to your private air-conditioned vehicle for transfer to your 5-star Cairo hotel. Upon check-in, your tour manager walks you through your full itinerary, confirms all tour timings, and ensures you are settled with a complimentary welcome beverage before a restful first evening in Egypt. If your flight arrives early, contact Bastet Travel in advance to arrange a suitable activity and make the most of your first day on this Egypt Tour Package. No meals are included on arrival day.

Day 2: Giza Pyramids, Egyptian Museum & Islamic Cairo

After a luxurious 5-star hotel breakfast, your private Egyptologist guide escorts you in a comfortable air-conditioned vehicle to the Giza Plateau — the opening act of your 8 Days Cairo to Aswan Tour and one of the most powerful experiences in all of travel. You visit the Great Pyramid of Khufu (built circa 2550 BC, originally 147 meters tall, assembled from approximately 2.3 million stone blocks), the Pyramid of Khafra (2540 BC), and the Pyramid of Menkaure (26th century BC), before standing before the Great Sphinx — a 73-meter limestone colossus — and touring the Valley Temple of Khafra. The Solar Boat Museum at the base of the Great Pyramid reveals the fully reconstructed Khufu Ship, a 43-meter cedarwood vessel buried beside the pyramid around 2500 BC. Lunch at a renowned local restaurant precedes an afternoon at the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities in Tahrir Square, where over 120,000 artifacts — including the complete Treasures Room of Tutankhamun — fill its storied halls. The optional Mummies Room is available on request. Your day closes in the Islamic Quarter of Old Cairo, where the Khan el-Khalili Bazaar — a 14th-century Mamluk-era market — offers an atmospheric end to the most varied day of this Egypt Tour Package. Overnight at your 5-star Cairo hotel.

Day 3: Flight to Luxor — Nile Cruise Embarkation & East Bank Temples

After breakfast at your Cairo hotel, a private transfer takes you to the airport for your domestic flight to Luxor — the moment your 8 Days Cairo to Aswan Tour transitions from the metropolis to the ancient river world of Upper Egypt. Dinner and overnight on board the cruise in Luxor — your Egypt Tour Package now fully afloat on the River Nile.

Day 4: Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut Temple & Sail to Edfu

Waking on the Nile to breakfast on board, your 8 Days Cairo to Aswan Tour crosses to Luxor's West Bank for a morning in Egypt's most celebrated royal landscape. The Valley of the Kings — a sealed desert valley containing over 60 rock-cut tombs where New Kingdom pharaohs including Tutankhamun, Ramses II, and Seti I were laid to rest — is followed by the Mortuary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir el-Bahari, a three-tiered colonnaded masterpiece built in the 15th century BC against the sheer limestone face of the Theban Mountain. Returning to the cruise for lunch, the ship sets sail south for Edfu as the Nile Valley landscape unfolds around you — dinner on board and overnight moored at Edfu close this landmark day of your Egypt Tour Package.

Day 5: Edfu Temple, Kom Ombo Temple & Arrival in Aswan

Breakfast on board opens one of the richest single days of the 8 Days Cairo to Aswan Tour. At Edfu, you visit the Temple of Horus — the best-preserved ancient temple in Egypt, built between 246 BC and 57 BC, with walls carrying the complete Myth of the Contending of Horus and Seth — before returning to the cruise for the sail to Kom Ombo. The Kom Ombo Temple — a uniquely symmetrical Ptolemaic structure dedicated equally to Sobek and Horus (332 BC–395 AD), located 40 km north of Aswan — is one of the most architecturally distinctive sites in this Egypt Tour Package. After the visit, the cruise sails onward to Aswan, with lunch and dinner both served on board as the Nile's southern landscape deepens around you. Overnight on board in Aswan.

Day 6: Aswan — High Dam, Philae Temple & Unfinished Obelisk

Breakfast on board opens the final full touring day of your 8 Days Cairo to Aswan Tour — a day in Aswan that combines ancient engineering with one of the ancient world's most revealing unfinished projects. Your guide takes you first to the Aswan High Dam — a 3.6-kilometer rock-fill dam completed in 1968 and inaugurated in 1971, which created Lake Nasser stretching over 550 km — then to Philae Temple, the last sanctuary built in the classical Egyptian style (dedicated to Isis, origins circa 690 BC, relocated to Agilkia Island between 1972 and 1980), and finally to the Unfinished Obelisk in Aswan's Northern Quarries, a 1,168-tonne abandoned granite monument that offers unparalleled insight into ancient Egyptian stoneworking. Lunch is served on board after touring, and the afternoon is free for personal exploration — dinner on board and a final overnight



on the Nile close this Egypt Tour Package day in Aswan.

Day 7: Disembarkation in Aswan & Return to Cairo

After a final breakfast aboard the cruise, you disembark in Aswan and a Bastet Travel representative escorts you to the airport for your domestic flight back to Cairo — the return leg that marks the transition into the closing chapter of your 8 Days Cairo to Aswan Tour. Upon landing in Cairo, your tour manager meets you at the airport and transfers you to your 5-star Cairo hotel for check-in. The remainder of the day is entirely at your disposal — whether you choose to rest, revisit a favorite neighborhood, or simply absorb the city at your own pace, the afternoon and evening are yours.
