Deep Dive into the Landmarks with the 8 Days Deal to Cairo

Cairo — Giza Plateau

The **Pyramids of Giza** are the architectural and historical anchor of the **8 Days Deal to Cairo**: the **Great Pyramid of Khufu** (c. 2560 BC, originally 146.5 meters, constructed from approximately 2.3 million stone blocks and the only surviving Wonder of the Ancient World), the **Pyramid of Khafre** (retaining its original polished limestone casing at the upper section, 136 meters), and the **Pyramid of Menkaure** (65 meters, notable for its paired subsidiary pyramids and valley temple). The **Great Sphinx** — a 73-meter monolithic limestone figure carved from a single bedrock outcrop around 2500 BC, believed to represent Pharaoh Khafre — stands



immediately east of the second pyramid on the plateau and completes the most recognizable ancient landscape in the world within the **8 Days Deal to Cairo**.

Cairo — Memphis & Saqqara

Memphis — Egypt's first capital, established around 3100 BC by Pharaoh Narmer at the unification of Upper and Lower Egypt — survives today as an open-air museum at Mit Rahina, 24 kilometers south of modern Cairo, preserving a colossal limestone statue of **Ramesses II** and a large **Alabaster Sphinx** from the New Kingdom. Three kilometers north, **Saqqara** is the royal necropolis of **Memphis** and the site of the **Step Pyramid of Djoser** — designed by the architect-physician Imhotep around 2650 BC as the world's first large-scale cut-stone structure, rising in six stepped tiers to 60 meters and surrounded by the most complete Old Kingdom funerary complex in Egypt; both **Memphis** and the **Saqqara Step Pyramid complex** give the **8 Days Deal to Cairo** its architectural depth beyond **Giza**.

Luxor — East Bank

The east bank of Luxor contains two of ancient Egypt's greatest surviving religious buildings within the **8 Days Deal to Cairo**. The **Karnak Temple Complex** — the largest religious structure ever built, covering approximately 100 hectares and incorporating additions by successive pharaohs across 2,000 years — is anchored by the **Great Hypostyle Hall** of the **Precinct of Amun-Ra**: 134 papyrus-shaped sandstone columns arranged across 5,000 square meters, the tallest reaching 21 meters, with ceiling paint and hieroglyphic reliefs still intact in sheltered sections. **Luxor Temple**, begun by Amenhotep III around 1380 BC and significantly expanded by Ramesses II, occupies the east bank corniche directly on the Nile — its entrance pylon, avenue of sphinxes, and colossal seated statues of Ramesses II defining the city's riverfront profile within the **8 Days Deal to Cairo**.

Luxor — West Bank

The west bank of Luxor places the funerary landscape of ancient Thebes at the center of the **8 Days Deal to Cairo**. The **Valley of the Kings** — a dry limestone wadi in the Theban hills used as the royal burial ground of the New Kingdom from approximately 1539 to 1075 BC — contains 63 known tombs, with three entries included; among them the tomb of Tutankhamun (KV62), whose burial chamber paintings and gilded shrines remain in situ as discovered by Howard Carter in 1922. The **Temple of Hatshepsut** at Deir el-Bahari — a three-terraced mortuary temple of extraordinary architectural precision built against a natural limestone amphitheater around 1479–1458 BC, its painted colonnade reliefs depicting the famous trading expedition to Punt — stands directly across the valley from the royal tombs and completes the west bank program of the **8 Days Deal to Cairo**.



Hurghada — Red Sea

Hurghada on Egypt's **Red Sea** coast sits opposite the southern **Sinai Peninsula** at a point where the continental shelf drops quickly into deep water, producing coral reef ecosystems of exceptional biodiversity directly accessible from the beach. The **8 Days Deal to Cairo** dedicates three nights here — enough time for snorkeling excursions to house reef sites, an optional desert safari into the Eastern Desert hills to visit a **Bedouin village**, and genuine resort relaxation without the itinerary pressure of the touring days. The **Red Sea at Hurghada** offers water temperatures between 22°C and 28°C year-round, making marine activities viable in every season of the **8 Days Deal to Cairo**.

Tour Itinerary

Day 1 — Arrival in Cairo

The 8 Days Deal to Cairo, Luxor & Hurghada begins at Cairo International Airport, where a Bastet Travel representative meets you with a personalized welcome, handles any arrival formalities, and transfers you by private air-conditioned vehicle to your Cairo hotel. Day 1 carries no monument program — the 8 Days Deal to Cairo reserves the first evening for rest, acclimatization, and orientation at your own pace. Overnight in Cairo.

Day 2 — Pyramids of Giza, Memphis & Saqqara

After breakfast, a private vehicle takes you to the Giza Plateau for a professionally guided morning at the Great Pyramid of Khufu, the Pyramid of Khafre, the Pyramid of Menkaure, and the Great Sphinx — with your Egyptologist guide providing structural, astronomical, and historical context at each monument. Following a local lunch, the itinerary moves south to Memphis at Mit Rahina, where the open-air museum preserves the colossal Ramesses II limestone statue, and then to Saqqara for the Step Pyramid of Djoser — the world's first large-scale cut-stone structure and the most complete Old Kingdom funerary complex in Egypt. Together, Giza, Memphis, and Saqqara give the 8 Days Deal to Cairo a full architectural and historical narrative of the pyramid age in a single day. Two optional evening activities are available: the Sound & Light Show at the Pyramids of Giza and a Nile dinner cruise. Overnight in Cairo. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch.

Day 3 — Fly to Luxor: Karnak, Luxor Temple & Valley of the Kings

An early domestic flight takes the 8 Days Deal to Cairo south to Luxor — approximately 45 minutes in the air — where your private vehicle and guide are waiting at the airport. The day covers both banks of the Nile in sequence. The morning opens at the Karnak Temple Complex on the east bank, with a focused guided tour of the Precinct of Amun-Ra, the Great Hypostyle Hall, and the processional avenue of ram-headed sphinxes connecting Karnak to Luxor Temple, which is visited next — its entrance pylon, courtyard of Ramesses II, and the inner sanctuary of Amenhotep III all covered in detail. After lunch, the tour crosses to the west bank for the Valley of the Kings, where three royal tomb entries are included — among them the tomb of Tutankhamun (KV62) — and the Temple of Hatshepsut at Deir el-Bahari, set against its natural limestone cliff amphitheater. The optional Karnak Sound & Light Show is available in the evening for guests who want to close the day at the temple complex under illumination. The 8 Days Deal to Cairo covers more of Luxor in this



single day than many multi-night packages manage. Overnight in Luxor. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch.

Days 4-6 — Red Sea Relaxation in Hurghada

A morning road transfer from Luxor takes the 8 Days Deal to Cairo east across the Eastern Desert to Hurghada on the Red Sea coast — approximately three hours through desert terrain with the Red Sea hills rising around you before the turquoise coastal strip appears ahead. Three nights in Hurghada are structured as open, guest-directed days with no fixed program. Snorkeling and diving excursions to the house reef or offshore coral sites are available through your hotel and can be arranged on arrival. The Bedouin desert safari option — an off-road 4x4 excursion into the Eastern Desert hills with a visit to a working Bedouin village — is a popular half-day choice that adds a cultural and landscape dimension to the Red Sea stay. Water sports, boat trips to offshore islands, and full resort days are all equally valid ways to spend the three days that the 8 Days Deal to Cairo reserves here for rest and recovery. Overnight in Hurghada (three nights). Meals: Breakfast daily.

Day 7 — Return to Cairo: Free Day

A morning transfer returns the 8 Days Deal to Cairo to Cairo — either by road or by domestic flight depending on the booking option selected — for a completely free final full day in the capital. The most popular way to use Day 7 is a guided visit to Khan El Khalili bazaar, the medieval market established in 1382 AD in the heart of Islamic Cairo, where copper workshops, spice merchants, perfume vendors, and fabric stalls occupy the same lanes they have occupied for six centuries. Additional sightseeing options — the Egyptian Museum, Old Cairo, the Salah El-Din Citadel — can be added to Day 7 on request. The 8 Days Deal to Cairo builds this open day deliberately into the structure: after six days of monuments, transfers, and reef excursions, a day without a fixed schedule is both practical and restorative. Overnight in Cairo.

Day 8 — Departure

After a final breakfast at the Cairo hotel, a private vehicle transfers you to Cairo International Airport for your departure flight. The 8 Days Deal to Cairo, Luxor & Hurghada concludes with the same quiet efficiency with which it opened — a Bastet Travel representative manages the airport send-off, and the journey home begins with the full weight of eight days covering ancient pyramids, New Kingdom temples, and one of the world's great coral reef coastlines. Meals: Breakfast.
