Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Hurghada to Luxor, The Colossal Walled Sanctuary of Karnak, Optional Horse Carriage City Tour, Parallel Riverside Luxor Temple & Sunset Felucca Sailing

Your grand 3-day expedition begins with an early morning pickup directly from your resort lobby in Hurghada by a private, deluxe air-conditioned vehicle. Enjoy a comfortable, scenic drive through the Eastern Desert mountains and down into the lush Nile Valley until you reach the ancient imperial capital of Luxor. Upon arrival, you will be met by your expert local English-speaking Egyptologist guide to begin an in-depth tour of the monumental Karnak Temple Complex. Standing across 347 acres, this is the largest religious complex ever constructed by human hands, representing the architectural contributions of generations of pharaohs. Walk through the massive columned forest of the Great Hypostyle Hall, admire the soaring obelisks, and stand beside the sacred lake. Next, you can opt for a wonderful Horse Carriage City Tour, riding through downtown Luxor to discover local Egyptian markets, hidden streets, and daily local life. Transfer to your luxury Luxor hotel for check-in. Overnight in Luxor.

Day 2: Optional Sunrise Hot Air Balloon Flight, The Hidden Valley of the Kings, Terraced Hatshepsut Temple, Colossi of Memnon & The Royal Valley of the Queens

Awaken before dawn to participate in an optional, breathtaking Hot Air Balloon Ride, drifting silently above the Nile and the west bank mountains to enjoy an unmatched panoramic bird's-eye view of the illuminated temples and ancient royal tombs as the sun rises over the horizon. After returning for breakfast at your hotel, join your private guide and vehicle for an in-depth tour of the classic Theban West Bank necropolis. Your morning begins within the rugged mountain canyons at the world-famous Valley of the Kings, the secretive final resting place for the rulers of the 18th to 30th dynasties. Explore three beautifully decorated rock-cut tombs, examining the exceptionally preserved plaster reliefs and colorful hieroglyphic paintings that outline the pharaoh's journey through the underworld, with options to purchase an entry ticket for the tomb of Tutankhamun or



Ramses II. Next, visit the spectacular Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut (Deir el-Bahari), a brilliant architectural masterpiece built on three rising terraced levels connected by wide central ramps against a dramatic mountain wall. Continue your tour to the towering Colossi of Memnon, two massive 700-ton twin sandstone statues representing Amenhotep III that originally guarded his long-lost mortuary temple. Conclude your day's tour at the Valley of the Queens, home to over 75 royal tombs of pharaonic queens, princes, and princesses, where you can opt to view the legendary, incomparably rich colorful murals inside the supreme Tomb of Queen Nefertari (No. 66). Day 3: The Sacred Complex of Medinat Habu, The Ramesseum of Ramses II, Artisan Tombs at Deir el-Medina & Return Drive to Hurghada

Tour the early temple built by Hatshepsut and Thutmose III, and explore the sprawling, deeply carved memorial temple of Ramses III, famous for its detailed reliefs depicting military victories over the Sea Peoples. Next, proceed to the Ramesseum, the grand mortuary temple of Ramses II, where you will marvel at the monumental fragments of his fallen 57-foot-high seated stone statue and study the historic reliefs illustrating the famous Battle of Kadesh and the Festival of Min. Continue your exploration to the unique archaeological zone of Deir el-Medina, the ancient village and burial ground of the royal craftsmen who carved and decorated the pharaonic tombs. Tour the beautifully detailed family tombs from the 19th and 20th dynasties, noting their exceptional craftsmanship on the slopes of the hills, and learn about the unique children's burials discovered within pottery jars and baskets along the slopes of Qurnet Murai.
