#### **Day 6: Ptolemaic Temple of Horus at Edfu, Symmetrical Sailing & Kom Ombo Riverside Double Temple**

Enjoy breakfast onboard before boarding a traditional horse-drawn carriage at 07:00 to visit the majestic Edfu Temple. Dedicated to the falcon god Horus, this remarkably preserved Ptolemaic



monument features soaring pylons and detailed stone inscriptions that recount ancient religious dramas. Return to the ship by 09:30 and enjoy a relaxing morning of sailing toward Kom Ombo. After lunch onboard at 12:30, step ashore at 15:30 to tour the unique Kom Ombo Temple, which stands on a scenic bend in the river. Explore its dual, symmetrical sanctuaries, split down the middle to honor both the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Haroeris. At 17:30, return to the vessel and enjoy dinner while sailing downriver to Aswan. Arrive in Aswan by 21:00 for an overnight stay onboard.

### **Day 7: Island Temple of Philae, Aswan High Dam, The Unfinished Granite Obelisk & Felucca Sailing**
