Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo, VIP Airport Greeting & Luxury Hotel Transfer

Your premium Egypt Tour Package officially begins as you touch down at Cairo International Airport. Day 2: Flight to Aswan, Philae Island Temple, High Dam & Felucca Sailing

Check out of your Cairo hotel in the morning and board a short, comfortable domestic flight to Aswan. Upon arrival at Aswan Airport, our local team will meet you and transfer you directly to your luxury Nile cruise ship for embarkation. Continue to the ancient granite quarries to view the Unfinished Obelisk, a 42-meter-long, 1,168-tonne monolithic block of solid red granite that offers unique insights into pharaonic stone-carving methods. At 4:00 PM, embark on a relaxing Felucca sailing trip around Elephantine Island and Lord Kitchener's botanical island. You can opt for an evening cultural excursion to the vibrant, rainbow-colored Nubian Village to experience their unique traditions. Enjoy dinner and a relaxing overnight on board the cruise ship in Aswan.

Day 3: Masterful Abu Simbel Temples & Symmetric Kom Ombo Temple

Savor an early breakfast on board your cruise ship. Spend your morning at leisure in Aswan or embark on an early morning excursion south to the spectacular Abu Simbel Temples. Carved directly into a solid sandstone cliff face between 1274 and 1244 BC by Ramesses II, the Great Temple features four colossal statues of the king guarding the entrance, while the Small Temple is dedicated to his beloved wife, Queen Nefertari, and the goddess Hathor. Return to the ship for a buffet lunch as the cruiser begins sailing north toward Kom Ombo at 1:00 PM. Upon arrival, step ashore to tour



the unique Temple of Kom Ombo, a perfectly symmetrical dual structure built during the Ptolemaic and Roman eras, divided equally between Sobek the crocodile god and Haroeris the falcon god. Return to the ship for dinner as it sails toward Edfu. Overnight on the cruise ship in Edfu.

Day 4: Majestic Edfu Temple via Horse Carriage, Esna Lock Transit & Luxor Temple at Night

Enjoy breakfast on board before boarding a traditional horse carriage to visit the spectacular Edfu Temple. Dedicated to the hawk-god Horus and founded in 246 BC under Ptolemy III, this monument stands as one of the most complete and beautifully preserved ancient temples in Egypt, featuring massive walls covered in detailed reliefs of the legendary conflict between Horus and Seth. Return to the cruise ship by 10:00 AM to relax and enjoy lunch on deck while sailing north toward Luxor, experiencing a smooth transit through the historic Esna Lock. After arriving on the east bank of Luxor at 6:00 PM, join your guide for an evening tour of the majestic Luxor Temple. Largely built by Amenhotep III and completed by Tutankhamun and Ramesses II, this illuminated structure features a massive first pylon decorated with detailed reliefs of the military Battle of Kadesh. Return to the ship for dinner and an evening of local entertainment. Overnight on the cruise ship in Luxor.

Day 5: Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut Temple, Sprawling Karnak & Flight to Cairo

Awaken early for an optional sunrise Hot Air Balloon flight (\$80 extra) over the west bank of Luxor for spectacular aerial views of the ancient temples.
