Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo, VIP Airport Greeting & Luxury Hotel Transfer

A professional airport representative from Bastet Travel will meet you inside the arrival terminal, providing attentive VIP meet and greet assistance through entry visa processing, passport control, and luggage collection. You will then be guided to your private, air-conditioned vehicle for a smooth transfer to your premium city hotel. After a seamless check-in, the remainder of your day is entirely at leisure to unpack, unwind, or enjoy your first evening in the vibrant capital. Day 2: The Monumental Giza Pyramids, The Great Sphinx & The Antiquities of the Egyptian Museum

Savor a delicious breakfast at your hotel before meeting your private Egyptologist guide for an extraordinary day exploring ancient world history. Your morning is dedicated to the iconic Giza Plateau, a monumental necropolis utilized since the Old Kingdom. Stand before the Great Pyramid of King Khufu, a staggering engineering marvel composed of 2.3 million limestone blocks. Continue to the Pyramid of King Khafre, which stands proudly alongside its historic mortuary complex, and the Pyramid of King Menkaure, the smallest of the triad, renowned for yielding spectacular historical sculptures. After a premium lunch at a top local restaurant in Giza, head to Tahrir Square to tour the world-renowned Egyptian Museum. Home to over 250,000 genuine artifacts spanning 5,000 years, the highlight is the breathtaking golden collection of King Tutankhamun, discovered intact in 1922. For an enhanced experience, you can request an optional visit (\$50 extra per person) to the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization (NMEC) in Fustat to explore the state-of-the-art Royal Mummies Hall. Return to your hotel for an evening at leisure. Overnight in Cairo.

Day 3: Flight to Aswan, Luxury 5-Star Cruise Embarkation, Philae Island, High Dam & Felucca Sail

Enjoy an early breakfast and check out of your Cairo hotel as your private chauffeur transfers you to



the airport for your short domestic flight south to Aswan. Upon landing, you will be met by our local representative and transferred to your luxury 5-star Nile cruise ship for embarkation and a fresh lunch onboard. In the afternoon, set out with your private guide to explore Aswan's classic landmarks. Take a scenic boat ride to Agilkia Island to explore the beautiful Philae Temple Complex, built around 690 BC to honor the goddess Isis and standing as the last outpost of classical Egyptian architecture. Next, view the Aswan High Dam, a massive rock-fill structure built between 1960 and 1971 that borders Egypt and Sudan to form Lake Nasser. Continue to the ancient northern quarries to inspect the majestic Unfinished Obelisk, a 42-meter-long block of solid pink granite weighing 1,168 tonnes that offers unparalleled insight into ancient stone-carving techniques. At 16:00, enjoy a romantic sailing trip aboard a traditional wooden Felucca around Elephantine Island, including a visit to Lord Kitchener Island (Botanical Gardens). You can also choose an optional excursion to an authentic, colorful Nubian Village to experience their unique cultural heritage and lifestyle. Return to the ship for an elegant dinner. Overnight onboard the cruise in Aswan.

Day 4: Overwhelming Abu Simbel Sun Temples & The Symmetric Riverside Sanctuary of Kom Ombo

Awaken early for a packed breakfast as you embark on an unforgettable morning excursion from Aswan to the legendary mountain-cut sun temples of Abu Simbel. Carved into the solid rock face between 1274 and 1244 BC under the reign of Ramses II, these twin structures stand as a pinnacle of ancient art and modern UNESCO engineering. Tour the Great Temple of Ramses II, featuring four colossal 20-meter-high seated statues guarding the entrance, dedicated to Amun-Ra, Ra-Horakhty, and Ptah. You will also explore the adjoining Small Temple of Queen Nefertari, built to honor the king's beloved wife and the goddess Hathor. After a thorough guided exploration, return to the cruise ship for lunch as the vessel begins its scenic voyage downriver to Kom Ombo at 13:00. Upon arrival, step ashore to visit the unique Temple of Kom Ombo, a flawlessly symmetrical double temple built during the Ptolemaic and Roman eras, shared equally between the crocodile god Sobek and the falcon god Haroeris. Return to the ship and enjoy a relaxing sunset sail to Edfu while savoring a gourmet dinner. Overnight onboard the cruise in Edfu.

Day 5: Carriage Tour of Edfu's Horus Temple, Esna Lock Crossing & Illuminated Luxor Temple by Night

Enjoy breakfast onboard before boarding a traditional horse carriage ride to visit the spectacular Edfu Temple. Dedicated to the falcon god Horus and founded in 246 BC under Ptolemy III, this soaring structure is the most completely preserved cult temple in Egypt. Its massive walls feature detailed inscriptions recounting the epic mythological battle between Horus and Seth. Return to the ship to enjoy lunch as the cruise sails north through the historic Esna Lock, arriving in the ancient



capital of Luxor. Disembark with your guide for an evocative evening tour of the majestic Luxor Temple. Founded by New Kingdom Pharaoh Amenhotep III and completed by Tutankhamun and Ramses II, this beautifully illuminated riverside monument features a grand first pylon carved with scenes of the historic Battle of Kadesh. In the evening, you can opt for an optional Sound and Light Show at Karnak Temple, which dramatizes the history of ancient Thebes. Return to the vessel for a premium dinner. Overnight onboard the cruise in Luxor.

Day 6: The Subterranean Valley of the Kings, Hatshepsut Terraces, Karnak & Flight to Cairo

Begin your morning with an optional, unforgettable sunrise Hot Air Balloon ride (\$100 extra per person) over the Valley of the Kings for panoramic aerial views of the ancient Theban necropolis. After breakfast onboard and cruise check-out, cross the Nile to explore the legendary West Bank. Tour the majestic Valley of the Kings, descending into deep, rock-cut chambers to view the vibrant pharaonic wall paintings and massive stone sarcophagi of the New Kingdom's pharaohs. Next, visit the striking Mortuary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut at Deir el-Bahari, a visionary terraced monument that blends seamlessly into the towering limestone cliffs. Pause for a photo stop at the Colossi of Memnon, two twin 18-meter-high stone statues of Pharaoh Amenhotep III. After a delicious lunch during the tour, recross the river to explore the East Bank's crowning jewel: the sprawling Karnak Temple Complex. Walk through the breathtaking Hypostyle Hall, a spectacular maze of columns, pylons, and obelisks built to honor the sacred Triad of Amun, Mut, and Khonsu. In the evening, transfer to the Luxor airport for your domestic flight back to Cairo. Upon arrival, check into your luxury capital hotel. Overnight in Cairo.
