Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Cairo, VIP Airport Greeting & Luxury Hotel Transfer

Overnight in Cairo.

Day 2: Old Kingdom Giza Pyramids, The Sphinx, Egyptian Museum & New Museum Galleries

Enjoy a delicious breakfast at your hotel before meeting your guide to explore the ancient wonders of the capital. Day 3: Journey to Bahariya Oasis, Volcanic Black Desert, El Haize Springs & Camel Trek to Wadi Agabat

Arrive at the Bahariya Oasis around 10:00 AM to meet your expert safari team and transition into custom 4x4 off-road Jeeps. Drive out into the surreal



landscape of the Black Desert, exploring the unique volcanic hills covered in black basalt powder. Continue to the historic eco-haven of El Haize Oasis to submerge yourself in a natural hot water spring to instantly loosen muscles and reduce stress before enjoying a traditional local lunch. Afterward, visit the glittering Crystal Mountain (Gebel al-Izzaz) to admire its sun-catching quartzite crystals. From here, meet your camel caravan and embark on an initial 8-kilometer camel ride into the breathtaking Valley of Agabat, an otherworldly landscape of ancient chalk and limestone formations that was an ocean bed millions of years ago. Set up your first desert camp in the peaceful "Matar" area. Enjoy a hot Bedouin dinner. Overnight camping in Wadi Agabat.

Day 4: Deep Desert Camel Safari, Makhroum Mountain Transit & Qaraween Dunes

Awaken to a magnificent desert sunrise followed by a fresh outdoor breakfast prepared by your Bedouin staff in the Valley of Agabat. Mount your camel to continue your deep desert safari, traveling 8 kilometers through a striking terrain of sweeping sand dunes and towering chalk cliffs. Arrive at the unique geological formation of Makhroum Mountain, a beautiful naturally perforated rock structure standing alone in the wilderness. Pause in the shade of the mountain to enjoy a freshly prepared nomadic lunch and rest during the midday heat. In the afternoon, continue your journey with a further camel ride, completing a total of 15 kilometers for the day, to reach the immense and vast expanse of the golden Qaraween Dunes. Savor breakfast over the campfire before setting out on your camels across the golden sands of Qaraween toward the most famous water source in the national park, The Magic Spring (Ain El Serw). Listen as your guide explains the ancient mystery behind this "Secret Spring," where the water level naturally rises to the surface when humans or animals approach and lowers when they depart. Enjoy a relaxing swim in the refreshing waters and savor a delicious lunch prepared under the shade of the desert palms. In the afternoon, continue your camel ride through the sweeping desert terrain until you reach the freshwater outpost of the Camel Spring (Ain Abu Hawas), a historic watering stop for passing caravans. From here, cross into the majestic Great Wadi to establish your third remote desert camp. Enjoy a fresh dinner around the campfire and listen to traditional Bedouin music under a clear, unpolluted starry night sky. Overnight camping in the Great Wadi.

Day 6: Camel Trek via Ain Khadra Oasis to the Monoliths of the White Desert

Enjoy breakfast in the quiet expanse of the Great Wadi before mounting your camels for a scenic morning trek toward the isolated oasis of Ain Khadra. This quiet, miniature desert haven features a sweet freshwater spring surrounded by wild palms, offering a perfect, tranquil location to rest and enjoy a fresh regional lunch prepared by your crew. In the afternoon, continue your 15-kilometer camel ride as you officially enter the core of the White Desert National Park. Watch in awe as the landscape transitions into a brilliant white canvas filled with hundreds of surreal chalk monoliths wind-sculpted over millions of years. As the sky turns pink and then a deep, fiery orange, watch the shadows fade across the white stone shapes. Assist your Bedouin staff in pitching your tents amidst the chalk shapes and enjoy a fresh dinner around the fire. Overnight camping in the White Desert.

Day 7: Exploring Wind-Sculpted Chalk Formations & White Desert Sunset Camp

Awaken early to witness a breathtaking sunrise as the morning light reflects off the brilliant white chalk landscape. After a fresh breakfast, spend your day enjoying an immersive camel ride through the heart of the White Desert, exploring the incredible natural rock sculptures scattered across the sands. Your guide will help you identify the hundreds of unique shapes, including the famous mushroom rocks, the stone tents, the sphinx-like mounds, and the iconic chicken-shaped rock. Stop for a relaxing lunch served in the shade of a massive limestone formation. In the afternoon, continue exploring the surreal field of sculptures, finding the perfect location to set up your final wilderness camp. As night falls and temperatures drop, put on a warm jacket and gather around the campfire to enjoy a special farewell desert dinner. Overnight camping in the White Desert.

Day 8: Final Camel Trek via Rabaw Spring, Bir Sigam Thermal Bath & Bahariya Oasis Exploration

Enjoy your final breakfast in the white wilderness before embarking on a final 15-kilometer camel ride from the White Desert to the tranquil water station of Rabaw Spring. Check into your local hotel and head directly to the famous thermal springs of Bir Sigam. Submerge yourself in the naturally hot, therapeutic waters to instantly soothe your muscles, remove travel stress, and promote a deep sense of tranquility after your multi-day trek.
